Letter from Stewardship Committee Chair

Dear Friends:

Stewardship is the virtuous response to what we have inherited: a fully paid for building, a community that accepts us where we are and encourages us, and a staff that cares deeply for our spiritual welfare and the nurture of our children.

To meet your expectations, your Session has provided the current level of programming and services. It costs about \$600,000 to staff and care for the place each year, more if we properly reserve for the wear and tear on our building. That equates to an average of \$7,000 for each of our 85 or so giving units.

Some of us cannot give that much; others not only carry their own share, but pitch in to help those who cannot. To sustain our program, the Session recommends that we each try to give at least \$7,000 and that, in any case, we each increase our support as much as we can to offset the rising cost of everything.

The Session also asks everyone to pledge for 2024. A pledge to WPC is not a contract. It's not even a promise. It's just an indication of your intentions assuming life unfolds as you expect. Things happen. Circumstances change. Should they change for you, we will strive with all the compassion we can muster to be encouraging and supportive. Wouldn't that be what you would long for from your church? So, pledge so that we can properly budget to responsibly deliver all that you have come to expect.

STOCK & ESTATE DONATIONS

For those wishing to donate stock or mutual fund shares to WPC before year-end, here are instructions. Tell your broker what stock and what amount of shares you wish to transfer. Provide your broker with the following information as applicable.

If to the **Operating Account** (for pledges or regular and special donations):

If to the **General Endowment**:

• Electronically transfer the stock to ETRADE - DTC #0385 for further credit to the account of Winnetka Presbyterian Church Account 5734 - 3768

IRA ANNUAL REQUIRED MINIMUM DISTRIBUTION (RMD)

Members older than 70½ can transfer up to \$100,000 per year from their traditional IRAs to charity, which can count as their <u>required minimum distribution</u> but is not taxable if the follow the rules for a qualified charitable distribution (QCD). *This doesn't apply to a Roth IRA, which has tax-free withdrawals and no required distributions.* The gift stays out of your adjusted gross income only if you make a direct transfer from your IRA to the charity. It doesn't count as a tax-free transfer if you withdraw the money first and then make a donation to the charity. Ask your IRA administrator what steps you need to take, because the procedures can vary from firm to firm. This can be especially important to members who do not itemize (Schedule A) on their taxes, or are borderline on deductions. Contact Bill Bringham for more information.
