

EASTER SUNDAY

APRIL 9, 2023



"Easter" comes from an old English word related to dawn and shining. At Easter we stand in the light of the resurrection to see a new creation, transformed by the grace and glory of God. The Resurrection of the Lord is the center of the Christian year, and the good news we proclaim on this day is at the very heart of the gospel.

As with Christmas, Easter refers not only to a single day, but to a whole season of celebration in the Christian year. The season of Easter spans the fifty days between the Resurrection of the Lord and the Day of Pentecost and encompasses the Ascension of the Lord. The seven weeks of the Easter season make up a "week of weeks" (seven times seven): a symbol in time of the fullness and abundance of God's grace. In ancient practice, fasting and kneeling were forbidden during the weeks of Easter. In this most joyful season, we celebrate the great mystery of our faith—that Jesus Christ is risen from the dead.



Alleluia! The Lord is risen indeed!


At last he came to us, that we might come to believe and proclaim this good news to the world.


How Can I Keep From Singing?

By your power he broke free from the prison of the tomb, and at his command the gates of hell were opened.


The one who was dead now lives.
