you claimed us as your own.

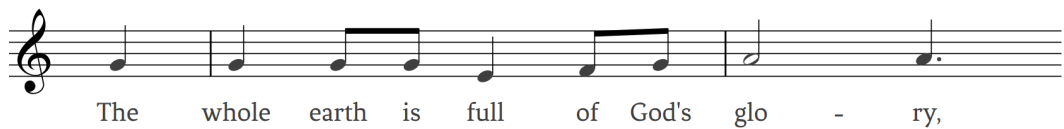
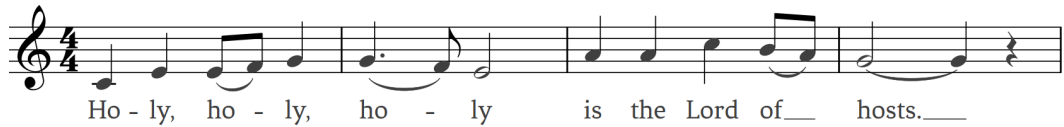
When we forgot our love for you,
