

Wash over us with your grace, and bathe us in your love, that we may remember who we are and whose we are.



## REMEMBRANCE OF BAPTISM | STANDING

Friends, whatever our journey to this point we remember that in baptism

God claims us as beloved children.

Baptism is the sign and seal of God's promises.




