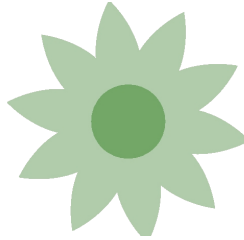

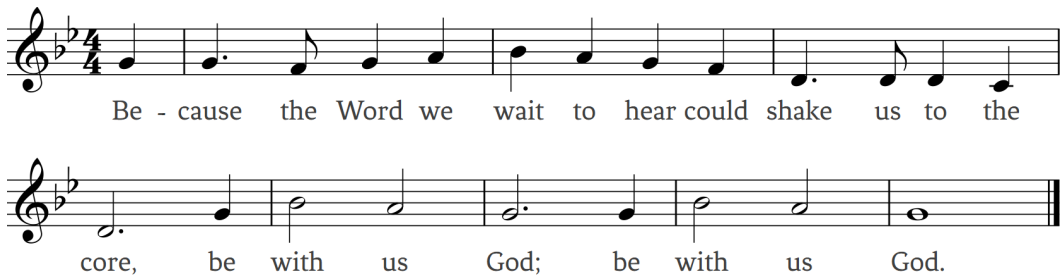

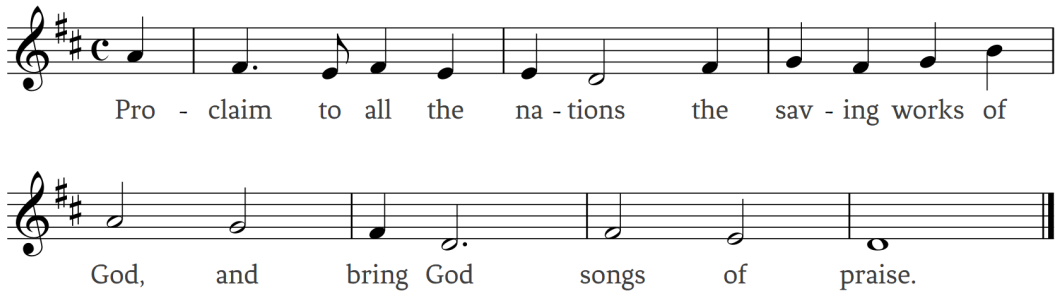

ALL CREATION SPEAKS HIS NAME


In the promise of the springtime, in the quiet after rain,
