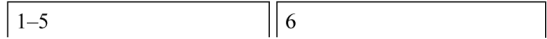


PRAYER OF CONFESSION

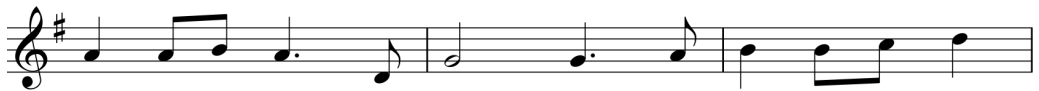
