Then let us sing songs of praise.


Are any among you sick?

You know me through and through: my body was no mystery to you, when I was formed in secret, woven in the depths of the earth.


Your eyes foresaw my deeds. and they were all recorded in your book; my life was fashioned before it had come into being.

and forgive us our debts as we forgive our debtors;


and lead us not into temptation, but deliver us from evil.


