and all we know has found its fulfillment,

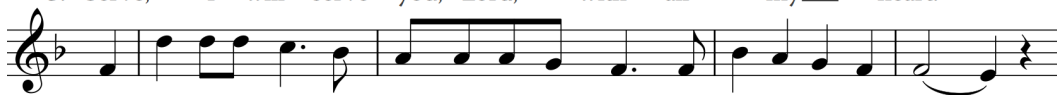
**you will still be God!**
