


# CALL TO WORSHIP | STANDING





# **REMEMBRANCE OF BAPTISM** | STANDING


Through our baptism we were claimed as God's beloved children,

wherever you have been,


come and celebrate this holy feast on this Easter day,

## GREAT PRAYER OF THANKSGIVING | STANDING




